



1. Go to your programs and select **Photo Story 3** to open it.
2. Select the **Begin a new story** option.
3. Click the **"Next"** button.



4. **Import and Arrange your pictures**-remove any black borders, rotate images, and complete some simple photo editing in this step. Move order of images in the timeline by dragging and dropping.



5. **Add text** to each image -You can use different fonts, alignment, etc. You can also add **image effects**. When finished, click the **next** button.



6. **Narrate your story**-Use the recording feature to start and stop the recording of your voice and to preview it for each slide. You can also **customize the motion** and timing of the images, similar to the PowerPoint program.
7. **Add background music** (either select an acceptable fair-use audio track from www.freeplaymusic.com or www.ccmixer.org or create your own music with the easy to use built-in tool.
8. **Save your story**- It is recommended that you save your project along the way by using the **Save Project** button. This saves the file and allows you to return to the file to continue working on it.
9. You may also want to upload your story to your wiki, blog, or web space. Users will typically save the story using **for playback on your computer** option, which creates a Windows Media file, playable with Windows Media player. Default resolution settings are 640x480, appropriate for playback on a computer.
